Project Officer Update Humberto Carvalho	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tom Coderre is acting assistant secretary of SAMHSA; Expect a newly confirmed assistant secretary Summer 2021. Continuation applications are due February 4, 2021. Requests for carryover of funds are to be done in the space provided on the FFR. Maximum carry over is 25%. Contact Humberto with questions. SAMHSA has received supplemental funding of 60 billion for efforts related to COVID-19 relief, with emphasis on self-care. Hope to create opportunities for ATTCs through new funding announcements. The GPRA TTC form will expire May 2022. SAMHSA is in the process of creating a new best practice tool. 	
Stimulant Work Group Update Tom Freese, Beth Rutkowski and Jeanne Pulvermacher	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Several components of the stimulant core curriculum were released to the public: core day long face to face curriculum, three-part virtual overview with 70-minute keynote, four of the seven supplemental modules and one of the three cultural modules. The pending components will soon be finalized and another release will begin in the coming weeks, along with a core curriculum data refresh. Work group meetings will resume in February. The national core curriculum should be used as a product created by the ATTCs; PDFs and slides are customizable with local data; editing rights have been limited as it is a national product. 	ACTION ITEM: Lena will add a link to the web page so the curriculum comes up in the products database.

Bryan is co-chair of the ORN Stimulants work group with Francis Levin from Columbia. <p>Update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The work group of seven people met with AAAP early November and will meet every 2 weeks; AAAP is interested in national subject matter experts. • They have summarized participant commitments and identified gaps in areas of expertise. • Next steps are vetting personnel then products. 	
<p>Self-care Work Group Update Kris Kelly</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conducted self-care focused listening sessions in 2020 for supervisors, for which they collected outcomes and created a summary. • Worked with NCO to compile activities from MHTTC, PTTC and ATTC; may use a librarian to curate the list; will work to identifying gaps in activities list. • Completed the self-care work group charter. • Discussing recruiting new members. • Meetings held the first Monday of the month, 12:00-1:00 pm CST; let Kris know if you want to join the March 1st meeting. • Self-care support will be focused on organizations rather than the individual; how organizations support their employees.
