## Training of Facilitators: Integrating HCV Services into **Opioid Treatment Programs**

Two or more diseases or health conditions that cluster within a population, facilitated by contextual and social factors, increases the health burden and can be referred to as a syndemic. Syndemic approaches to addressing health burdens created by two or more diseases or epidemics are more and more a focus of the federal government.

- This training will focus on building and facilitating a Learning Community for opioid treatment programs (OTPs) seeking to integrate HCV testing and treatment into their setting.
- The Learning Community Facilitation skills you'll learn will be adaptable to addressing other emerging public health issues (e.g., HIV, STIs, Harm Reduction).
- The content of this Training of Facilitators is built around a tested Learning Community process with OTPs from across the country.
- You will leave this 2-day training with ALL of the resources and tools needed to start and lead your own Learning Community, including a complete curriculum.

We are inviting one member of your ATTC leadership (Director, Associate Director, Project Manager) to be the champion for establishing a Learning Community in your region and one training facilitator to learn the Learning Community facilitation process. Both individuals will benefit from the content of this two-day training.
