After nearly four decades as a professor of psychology and psychiatry at three universities, Gary Bond is employed as a senior research associate at Westat, a Maryland-based research consulting firm.

His career has centered on the evaluation, dissemination, implementation, and sustainment of evidence-based practices for people with serious mental illness, including Individual Placement and Support (IPS) and assertive community treatment.

His recent work has examined the national spread of IPS through a learning community. He has also collaborated on two recent controlled trials of the impact of technical assistance on implementation of evidence-based practices.
